They’re deeply **insightful, temperamental**, and resourceful during crisis. They excel in business because of their flexibility, **adaptiveness**, and they take a practical approach to life. They love to make work fun. Despite their **impulsiveness**, their **flexibility** is their greatest unique ability.

Spontaneous’ are quick-witted and make decisions **QUICKLY** and **EMOTIONALLY**. They’re **independent thinkers** who prefer **immediate action** rather than making plans for their future. **Vitality** is their “middlename” and **drama** is their default. They’re highly assertive, but not often **don’t finish what they start**. Their **passion** and **charm** are the two key pillars of **influence** responsible for their success in life.

This temperament emerges as the **INFLUENCER-of-the-group**. They do get bored easily if they’re not challenged. They **prefer action over strategy**, and they have the “gift-of-gab,” which is complemented with a dynamic sense of humor. This temperament tends to be **OPEN** with sharing information, yet **DIRECT** when communicating with others. They like to get-to-the-point fast, but they love “**small-talk**.” When sold to, Spontaneous’ secretly ask themselves this primary question: “**WHY is your solution best for my needs?**”

Now A Bit More About Your Heroes



Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

You, like Mozart, are probably someone who is warm, enthusiastic and imaginative. Like Hepburn, perhaps you're sometimes temperamental but at the same time you're a thorough professional. You see life as being full of possibilities. You can make connections between things, such as events and information, and you can see patterns. You need affirmation from others - you need praise for what you do - but you also give praise and lend support to others.

Let's look at Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. He was an innovator who wrote over 600 works, many of them masterpieces of symphonic, chamber, piano, operatic and choral music. He remains perhaps the most popular of all classical composers.

Lucille Ball

The actress Lucille Ball was not only one of the most popular and influential Hollywood stars, with a career that spanned five decades, she was a leading television executive and an innovator in television production. She had a far-ranging impact on the quality of television production, and helped to foster in changes in the way women were regarded by the public, since despite her portrayal of a dizzy redhead she proved that a beautiful woman could be funny, that an actress could be a smart businessperson and that a woman could be a successful working mother.

Ball was one of the first to break an ethnicity barrier on television by insisting that her husband, Desi Arnaz, a Cuban (and naturalized American citizen) perform alongside her on television, at a time when CBS executives believed that an American and a Cuban marriage would not appeal to a wide audience (they were proved wrong, as the series was one of the most influential and popular of all time).

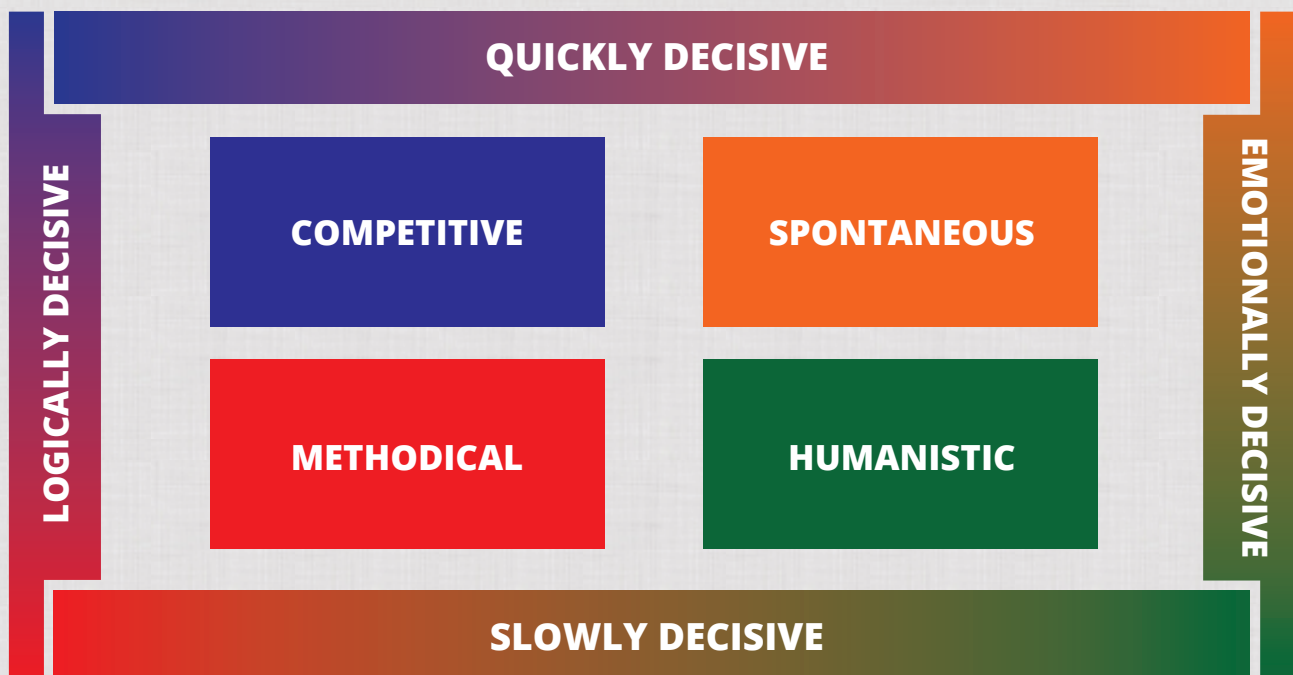
Katharine Hepburn

The renowned American film and stage actress, had a career that spanned six decades, and inspired many women to assert their independence. She became known for playing a strong-willed, sophisticated woman who had the ability to laugh at themselves, and her spirited personality and outspokenness helped change the perception of women over the course of the 20th century.

When her career hit a snag in the late 1930s, she hired a writer to craft a play for her. It became a hit play and a hit movie classic: *The Philadelphia Story*, reviving her career. She won 3 Academy Awards and had a career lasting 60 years, almost unheard of for an actress.

Like the Heroes Mozart, Ball and Hepburn you have the following qualities

- You think on your feet, though you may rush to jump into a situation that isn't entirely suitable for you.
- You're an independent-minded thinker who wants to act rather than sit still.
- You're able to make the most of what you're presented with, and to prosper.
- You can be assertive, which will help you in business; charming – which helps you in all walks of life.
